South Kensington station scheme secures a green signal



On 12th December the Planning Inspectorate allowed the two appeals by Native Land (Kensington) Limited, TTL South Kensington Properties Ltd and London Underground Ltd against the refusals by the Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea of planning and listed building applications. We had submitted two representations on the original planning application, on 18th February and 26th March 2021, and again to the Planning Inspectorate on 1st September 2022. All had made clear that our sole interest was in measures to secure the provision of step-free access between the street and sub-surface Circle and District line platforms.

Britain's Growing Railway in London and South East: January birthdays

~ 5^{th} , in 1981 – restoration of passenger services from Barking into Gospel Oak instead of Kentish Town, after a 55-year break.

~ 8^{th} , in 1996 – Ashford International connected to the European high-speed network when Eurostar began serving the station, but withdrawal of services from Kent's two stations continues indefinitely.
