Project Description	<p><u>Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance</u></p> <p>Bideford Town Council recognises the importance of multiple transport links to the rest of the country and aims to see Bideford reconnected to the national rail network for the benefit of the local economy and community as soon as practically possible.</p> <p>This Council therefore RESOLVES</p> <p>1)To join the Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance as a founding member</p> <p>2)To call on other public bodies, voluntary and business stakeholders and others to take an active role in the Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance.</p> <p>3) Support ACE Rail 'Reconnection 2040 Agenda' to see Bideford fully reconnected to the national rail network by 2040</p> <p>4)Urge both Neighbourhood Plan Steering Committee and Torridge District Council Local Plan Committee to reflect this desire in any plans they bring forward for public consultation.</p> <p>5)To urge the Torridge Levelling Up Partnership to use the funding made available to it by governmentt to advance the cause of reinstating the railway line from Barnstaple to Bideford.</p> <p>6)To host the inaugural meeting of the Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance by 31st March 2024 and work with its other members to promote the reconnection of Bideford to the national rail network.</p>
