Getting to Shoreditch Town Hall

- **Shoreditch Town Hall** is located near the corner of Old Street, Shoreditch High Street and Kingsland Road
- **By tube or rail: Liverpool Street station** (15 minutes' walk or 5 minutes' by bus) or **Old Street station** (Exit 3 - 7 minutes' walk). **Shoreditch High Street Overground station** is located at the corner of Bethnal Green Road and Braithwaite Street approximately 8 minutes' walk away. **Hoxton Overground station** is approximately 7 minutes' walk away on Geffrye Street behind the Geffrye Museum on Kingsland Road.
- **By bus:** Routes 26, 35, 47, 48, 55, 67, 78, 135, 149, 242 and 243 stop nearby.
- **By car:** Shoreditch Town Hall is outside the Congestion Charge area, which does not operate at weekends, but parking is very restricted and mostly metered. The Town Hall has no dedicated parking spaces.
- **By bicycle:** There are cycle racks on Old Street a few yards from the Town Hall entrance.
