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

- Deliver sustainable economic growth
- Speak with one voice on behalf of constituent local transport authorities
- Advise Sec of State about the development and prioritisation of transport investment
- Develop a Transport Strategy
- Co-ordinate transport functions across the region on behalf of the constituent authorities (e.g. smart and integrated ticketing)



Our mission

TfSE - progress

- 16 LTAs, 5 LEPs, 2 NPAs, 46 boroughs and districts
- Recognised by DfT, including £1m grant to develop transport strategy
- Subscriptions from constituent authorities
- Small staffing structure of 8 people
- Formal consultation on draft proposal to Government
- Identified priority schemes for Major Road Network
- Identified spending priorities for RIS2




STB Transport Strategy Develop

- Link to Continuous Modular Strategic Planning (CSMP) process






Transport Strategy Route Map



- Enhance the role of freight on the railways
