- ~ finalised our responses to Lewes District Council's consultation on 'Issues and Options' for its next Local Plan, and to Greater North Kent / AW2E Partnership's second consultation on 'Improving transport links between Abbey Wood and Ebbsfleet'.
- ~ responded for Railfuture to the Call for Evidence by the House of Lords Built Environment Committee for its Inquiry into 'Meeting the UK's housing demand'.
- ~ led on Railfuture's response to the Call for Evidence by the House of Lords Built Environment Committee for its Inquiry into 'the Williams-Shapps Plan for Rail – fare reform' on the future of rail fares.
- ~ led on Railfuture's response to Transport Focus / London TravelWatch on LNER's proposed changes to their ticket office opening hours.

- ~ contributed to online SCRP Steering Groups for the Uckfield and East Grinstead lines, the Tonbridge-Redhill-Reigate line, and MarshLink.
- ~ participated in the official launch of a SCRP-backed project next to Farnborough North station.
- ~ observed the All-Party Parliamentary Rail Group on "A Vision for British railways" with MD for First Group's new Lumo open access services, and MD for Arriva UK Trains which operates established Grand Central.

 Transport Forum of Transport for the South East.

Britain's Growing Railway in London & the South East: October birthdays

- ~ Arlesey, in Central Bedfordshire, reopened on the 3rd in 1988 after a BBC (Before Beeching Closure) in 1959.
- ~ Kentish Town West reopened on the 5th in 1981 after a fire a decade earlier had necessitated its closure.
- ~ How Wood opened as a new station on the Abbey line on the 22nd in 1988 as the line was electrified.
- ~ new Chiltern services between London Marylebone and Oxford Parkway, via the new Bicester chord and reopened stations at Islip and Bicester Village, began on the 26th in 2015 a first glimpse of East-West Rail!
