I would like to thank Mr Roger Blake for inviting me to say a few words to mark the start of the second annual stakeholder gathering of the Northern Devon Railway Development Alliance.

It is a pleasure to be able to welcome you all to Barnstaple today. This is an important occasion which will give us all the opportunity to hear about the exciting developments over the past 12 months.

The two years have quickly passed since the Alliance was inaugurated in late-2023 by Bideford Town Council, followed by the Tarka Rail Association and Railfuture, and now there are many participating stakeholders involved as evidenced by the representatives here today.

I am aware that the modernisation of the North Devon (Tarka) line was advocated in the draft Devon and Torbay Local Transport Plan for 2025-2040 and that it meets the criteria for Peninsula Transport's Strategic Implementation Plan and as a basis for the extension of rail services to Bideford.
