

What's happening?

From **Saturday 21 until Sunday 29 March 2026**, track renewals, planned for over a year, mean rail replacement services will be running between Barnstaple / Okehampton, CREDITON and Exeter St Davids.

Will rail replacement services appear in journey planners?

Yes! In fact, they're there now, so do please check before you travel as some stations will have a limited bus service or require a change of bus.

Can I use local bus services instead?

Yes! Your rail ticket will be accepted on the following local buses:

Stagecoach:

- **5** - Exeter to CREDITON
- **5A** - Exeter to Okehampton via CREDITON
- **5B** - Exeter to Barnstaple via CREDITON
- **5C** - Exeter to Chumleigh via CREDITON

Dartline:

- **66** - Exeter to Okehampton

Rail replacement departures from Barnstaple at 0645 and 0759 will run through to Exeter Central.

Replacement bus services

To eliminate confusion, all bus pick-up points have new yellow signs in place. You can also check the locations online at **Nationalrail.co.uk/stations**

As space is limited on buses or coaches compared to trains, please don't bring onboard:

- Large items of luggage
- Bikes (excluding folding bikes)
- Dogs (excluding assistance dogs).

Pushchairs must be folded up and stored as luggage. Seat belts, where fitted, must also be worn as it is a legal requirement.

Please note there are normally no toilet facilities provided on replacement buses or coaches.
