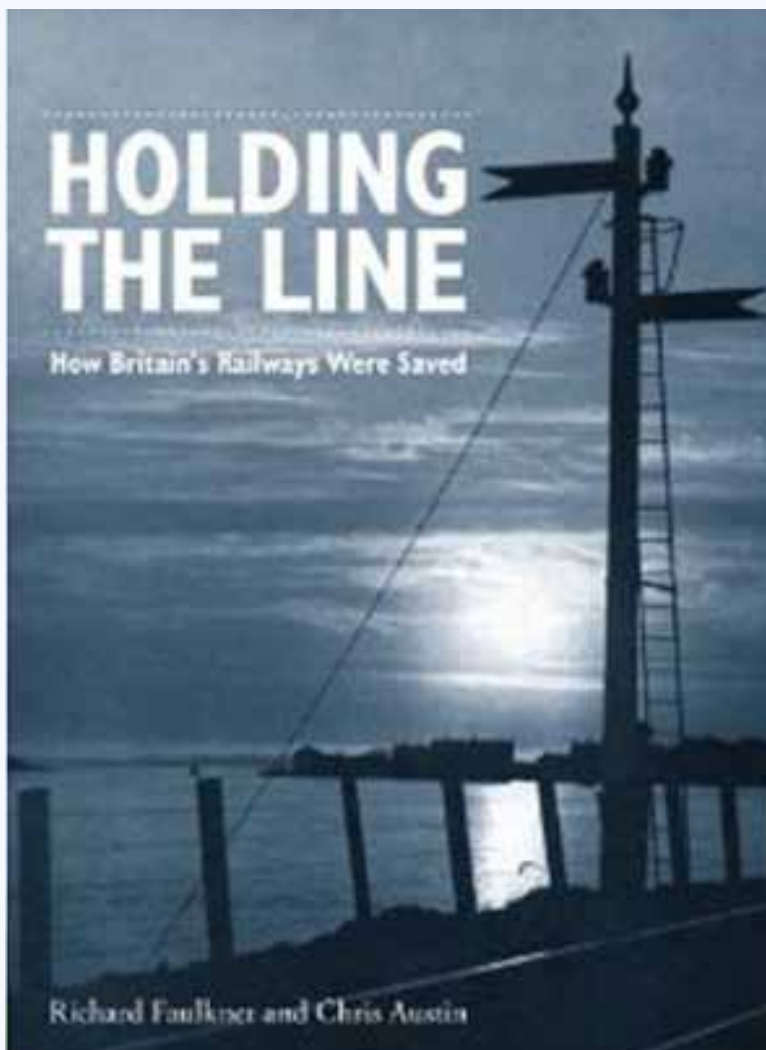

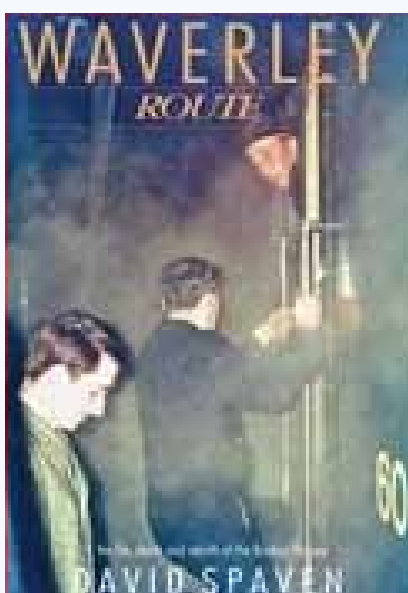
How Britain's railways were saved
