The venue, south of Hills Road bridge, is a seven-minute walk from Cambridge station entrance (via the path next to the guided busway)

Guest Speaker: MARTIN SEIFFARTH, Public Affairs Manager, Network Rail

Cambridge South station (costing more than £200m, which includes two additional tracks and other enhancements) was given planning approval in December 2022 and work began just weeks later. It is scheduled to open in 2025.

The new station will serve the Biomedical Campus and the various hospitals (including Addenbrooke's and the Royal Papworth). Railfuture has been campaigning for a station here since the 1980s and has met Network Rail to advise on what facilities are needed for passengers. This is your chance to find out what is planned, and perhaps influence aspects of the design before major construction begins.



In addition to this presentation there will be an update of Railfuture campaigns across East Anglia and a chance for you to express your views and ask questions.

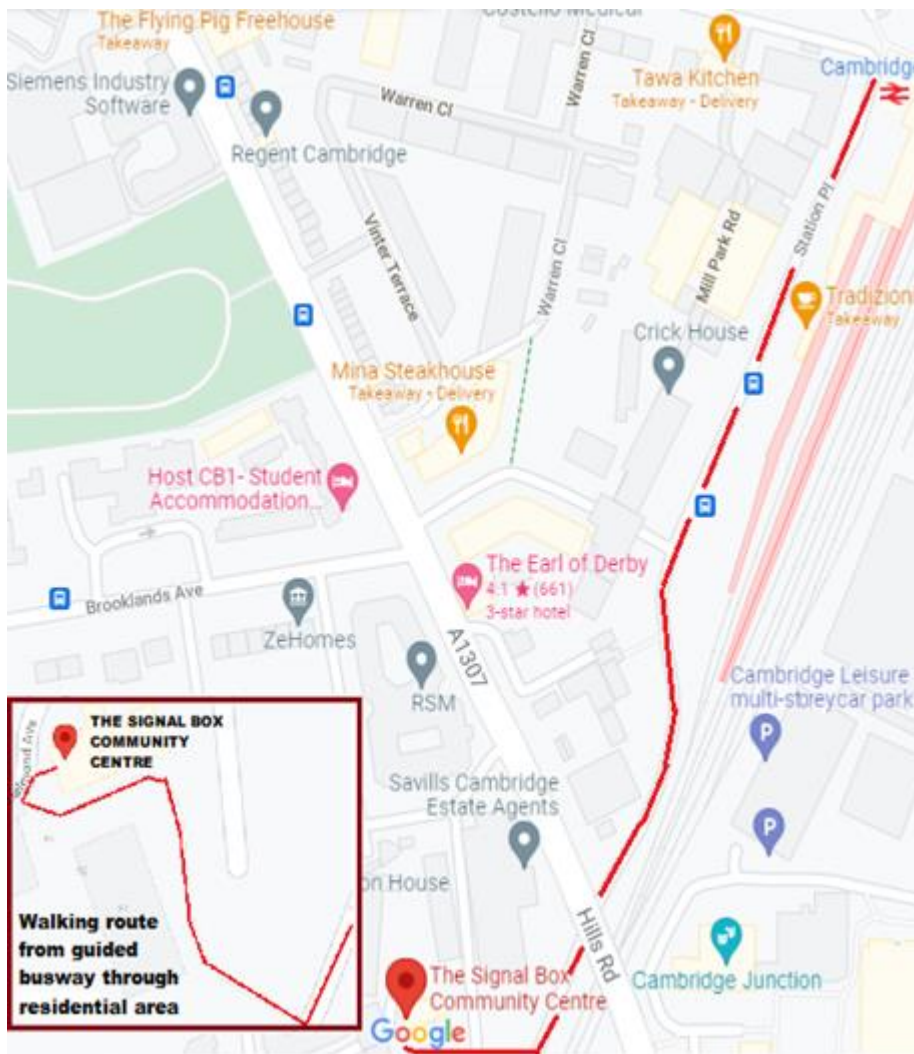
