### Walking route from **Railway Station**:

Walk out of station straight along Station Road and turn right into Hills Road. Over road junction with traffic lights (Catholic Church is on left) into Regent Street. Continue walking as it becomes St Andrew's Street. After Lion Yard (on your left) continue along pedestrianised Sidney Street. Immediately after the Round Church (on your right) turn right into Jesus Lane. The Friends Meeting House is on your left at the junction with Park Street.

It is a short bus journey from Cambridge station (Citi 1 or 3) to the stop opposite Christ's College (on Hobson Street) and then five minutes' walk.
