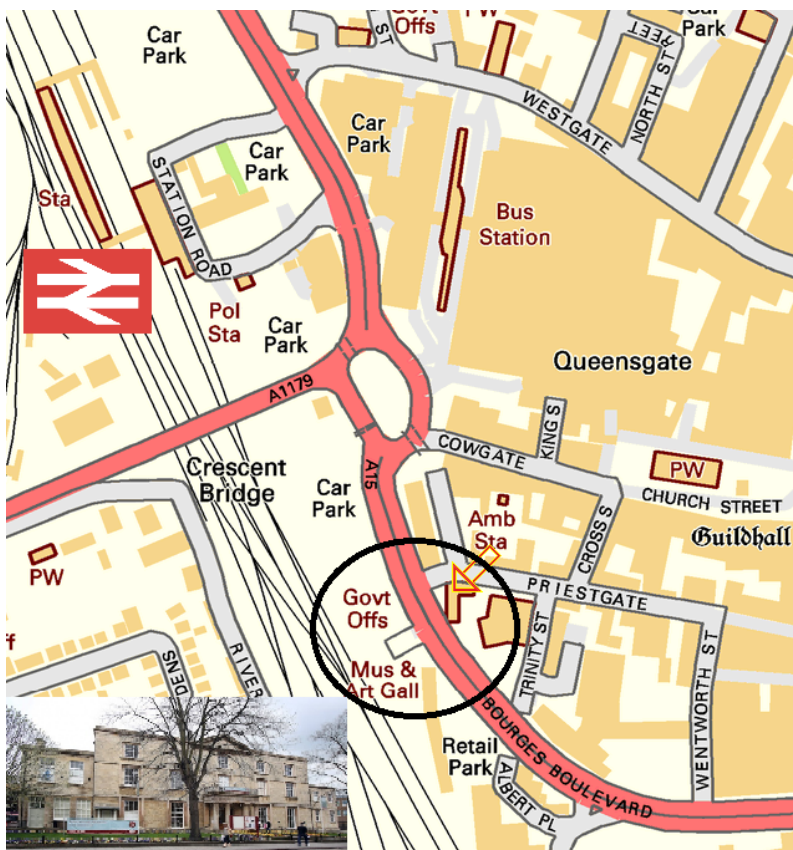

DIRECTIONS FROM STATION

Follow the **Station Approach** towards Bourges Boulevard taking the **footpath on the right**, and go past the multi-storey car park and **down the slope to the underpass** which leads across the large roundabout. Follow the signs to 'Cathedral and City Centre' **under two flyovers** and then **take the steps on the left** that lead up to the end of Cowgate. **At the top turn right** along the short cul-de-sac which has the 'Peterborough Telegraph' building on its right hand side. **This leads into Priestgate**. Turn **Left** and the **Museum entrance is almost immediately on your right hand side**.

FROM THE BUS STATION

Go to the south end of the bus stops, cross to the left-hand side and cross over the end of Cowgate, on your left. Follow the cul-de-sac past the Peterborough Telegraph building into Priestgate, on your left. The Museum entrance is on your Right.



If travelling by car, there is a medium-stay car park 50 metres away behind the Museum.
