CAMBRIDGE STATION IMPROVEMENTS FOR PASSENGERS AND VISITORS

Funding from the cb1 redevelopment of the area around Cambridge station will see the crowded station ticket hall tripled in size in 2014 and creation of a multi-storey cycle park with nearly 2,900 spaces (the largest cycle park in the UK). Geraint Hughes, Greater Anglia Partnerships Manager, will be talking about how these and other improvement will benefit passengers.

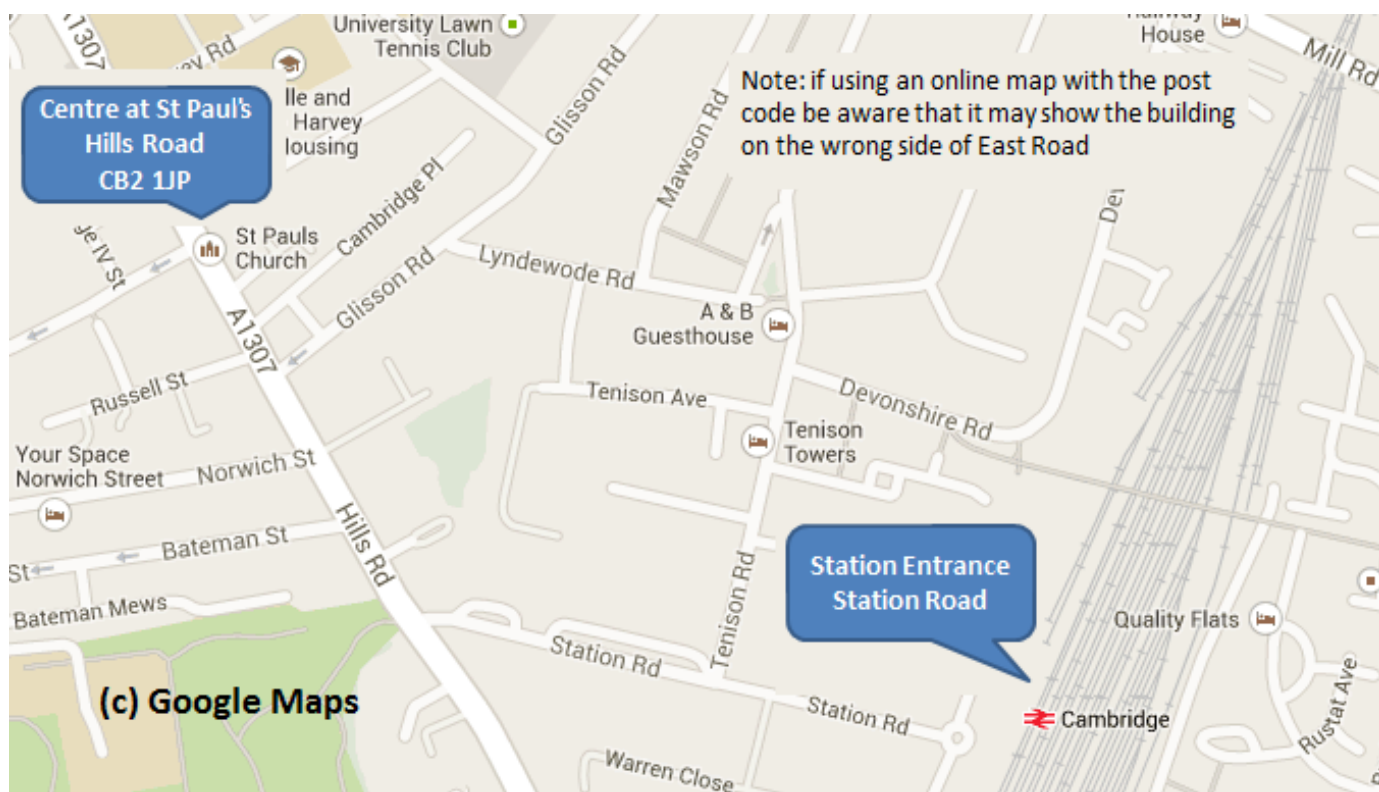
Mr Hughes is well known to Railfuture members for his involvement in their Adopt-A-Station initiative.

Directions to The Centre at St Paul's, Hills Road, Cambridge, CB2 1JP



By train: The walk from the railway station takes between 5 and 10 minutes. Continue straight out of the station entrance and along the right hand side of Station Road. At the junction with Hills Road turn right and continue on the right hand side until St Paul's Church Centre at the junction of Hills and St. Paul's Road.

By bus: Take the no 1, 3, 7 or 8 to the second stop on Hills Road called St Paul's. If coming from the City Centre these bus routes start at Emmanuel Street stands.
