Guest Speaker: PHIL HUTCHISON, Head of Strategic Planning, GTR

One of Phil Hutchison's main roles is developing train timetables, which need fine tuning to cram in as many services as possible whilst having a reliable railway. Noone claims this is an easy task!

Phil last spoke to Railfuture in 2017 at the national AGM, on the day before Cambridge North station opened. He now has to worry about trains calling at Cambridge South station (from 2025), which has two additional tracks and enhancements at Shepreth Branch Junction and at Cambridge station to improve capacity and reliability.



In additional to this presentation there will be an update of Railfuture campaigns across East Anglia and a chance for you to express your views and ask questions.
