The Felixstowe to Nuneaton Railway upgrade

Mr Eccles will describe the plans and progress of the nationally important upgrade of the railway through our region to take the increasing amount freight being put onto rail at Felixstowe and the inland terminals. Not only will this also lead to a better railway for our vital passenger services, it will give the railway much more capacity to take hgv traffic off the increasingly expensive and dangerous A14 trunk road.

The venue is right in the city centre accessed from within the Grand Arcade and Lion Yard shopping centres at first floor level. Escalators and lifts are available. These centres are on St Andrews Street next to the stands of buses arriving from the station. The Conference Room is on the 2nd floor of the Library, opposite the very good café.

From the railway station it is a 10- to 15-minute walk. From the new station bus stands to the left of the station entrance, all buses go to the city centre. Bus 1,3,7,8 go to stops on St Andrews Street ("City Centre"). Guided bus A or C will drop you off at New Square, entailing a short walk back across Christ's Piece into St Andrews Street. Green Park & Ride bus (destination Milton P&R) stops in Emmanuel Street, 1 min from St Andrews Street.
