Trains leave Colchester North Station for Colchester Town station at xx.20, xx.41, xx.56.



Turn left out of Town station and walk along Magdalen Street until you arrive at the YMCA.

A landmark on the opposite side of the road to the YMCA is Aldi's supermarket.

*From Colchester North Station* you can also take any bus to the High Street and alight at the 2<sup>nd</sup> stop, opposite Marks & Spencer, then a no.64 or 64A to Magdalen Street opposite Aldi's and just past Town station. If you wish to walk from High Street bus stops, continue in the direction of the bus to the Tourist office, opposite the castle, where you turn right into Queen Street. Continue down to St. Botolphs Street to Town Station and into Magdalen Street. This walk is up to 10 minutes.
