Guest Speaker: JONATHAN ROBERTS, Consultant engaged by Railfuture

Following a competitive tender, Railfuture East Anglia has appointed highly respected consultant Jonathan Roberts (of JRC) to undertake the research for its “East Anglian Rail Study”, which looks at how the region’s rail network can be developed to attract more passengers and freight.

Jonathan will be presenting his initial findings and ideas and then taking questions. He worked for Railfuture on previous projects, including making the case to reopen Lea Bridge station on the Stratford-Tottenham Hale route.



The presentation will be in the second part, after a break for refreshments. The meeting will commence with the branch AGM, which will include a report from the chair, Nick Dibben, including an update of Railfuture campaigns across East Anglia.
