St Neots

- Mark the exit road with lanes for exiting left or right to reduce journey times for passengers using car or taxi in peak periods
- Provide heating in at least one passenger area (for example ticket office or ticket gate area)
- Improved signage including walking routes to bus stops and the town centre
- Extra train information displays at the ticket gates giving full lists of station stops
- Additional shelter at the foot of the footbridge for queueing passengers
- Additional seating

Huntingdon

- Additional cycle parking once the new road has been detailed
- Additional platform shelters for passengers alighting in heavy rain from 8 and 12 carriage trains
- Additional seating
