
### Connecting Cambridge by Rail

- Rail's advantages can shift road users onto rail
- Park and Ride from near the journey origin
- Rail enhancements viewed positively
- 10 million users per year at Cambridge station with 6% growth
- New stations at Cambridge North and Cambridge South




# From Harlow, Bishops Stortford, Stansted Airport and Audley End; the M11 corridor




