


Growing Norwich

- Greater Norwich Plan
- 50,000 homes: 2012 to 2036
- Norwich Area Transportation Strategy (NATS)
- Role of rail











Norwich Connections by rail

- London Norwich in 90
- Cambridge
- Midlands and North
- Future East West Rail
- International connections Stansted Airport/Eurostar
- Local rail services case for expansion





Norwich – Ely rail route

Minimum three trains per hour (Atkins)

- Improved timings
- Electrification in long run
- Accessible stations Wymondham





Wherry Lines (Norwich – Great Yarmouth / Lowestoft rail routes)

- Three trains per hour both lines? (Atkins)
- Faster timings
- Extension of some Yarmouth services beyond Norwich
- Improve bus connections with Yarmouth station and approach





Bittern Line (Norwich – Cromer/Sheringham rail route)

- Half-hourly service to North Walsham
- New station for Dussindale
- Improved bus connections with trains: eg Holt


- Long Stratton/South Norfolk parkway
- Hethersett/West Norwich parkway

Retain possibility of feasibility study in NATS

The Final Mile (Beyond the railway station)

- High-frequency bus service (incl. evenings)
- Promote integrated fares Plusbus
- Real time information at bus stops
- Completion of core routes and city centre improvements
- Rail station UEA axis core route
- Conversion to electric or other non-polluting buses




East West Rail Update

- Central Section board met on 25 September 2017
- Central section route not yet selected
 - Options have narrowed
 - Bedford St Johns 'paused' on environmental grounds
 - □ Tunnel under Cambridge rejected on cost grounds
 - Route will enter Cambridge via 'grade separated' Shepreth Branch Junction
 - 4-track railway into Cambridge from Shepreth Junction
 - 2 x island platforms (4 platform faces) at Cambridge South (Addenbrooke's hospital and Biomedical Campus)



East West Rail – nodes in study Feb 2017




4 x 4 x 2 = 32!

East West Rail Update

Electrification still preferred for new build section

- BCR still between 1.9 and 2.0
- Cost between £1.6 and £2.9bn
- Route options depend on housing assumptions
 - □ NR using transport project methodology
 - □ NIC use 'Wider Economic Benefits' methodology
 - □ Improves the business case but opens up choice
- NIC final report due late autumn 2017


East West Rail Update – other items

- Attended by Will Gallagher and Stephen Barker of 'East
 - West Railway Company' and Dave Sexton from DfT
 - East West Rail very much in the spotlight
 - □ one of 5 major projects
 - □ Meet with minister every 2 weeks!
 - □ Minister wants faster delivery (2020s not 2030s)
 - EWR supported by Mayor of London



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

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East West Rail Update – Atkins Study Very Early Options Assessment

Route Option	Cost	Markets Served	Journey Times
Route Option 1 (Norwich via Thetford and Ely via Bury, existing routes)	Medium infrastructure requirement	All necessary markets served	Cambridge to Norwich/Ipswich in 60 minutes
Route Option 2 (All via existing Bury St Edmunds route with Haughley north curve)	Medium infrastructure requirement	Breckland growth less well served	Slightly faster than Route Option 1
Route Option 3 (New railway between Cambridge and vicinity of Haughley junction)	High infrastructure requirement	Local markets between Cambridge and Norwich/Ipswich less well served	Considerably faster than Route Options 1 and 2





East West Rail Update – other items

- Mayor of Cambridge & Peterborough Combined Authority to be invited to join the consortium
- Briefed by Cambridge County Council on rail matters in Cambridge (2 hours!)
- All-Party Parliamentary Group Event to be held prior to Chancellor's Autumn Statement (November 2017)
 - □ Much has happened since the last one!
 - □ 2 x general elections of new MPs to brief!





East West Rail Update – Possible action by Railfuture East Anglia

'East West Railway Company' brief does not specifically

include the 'Eastern Section'.

Does not specifically **<u>exclude</u>** it either!

- Should Lobby Secretary of State to include Eastern Section works in company remit
 - Better business case for central section with enhanced eastern section
 - Earnings from additional freight
